

PRESENT CHALLENGE

ANGELIC MESSAGE Change

Change, when it is lived as a sacred process, portends spiritual transformation. All levels of change, no matter how slight or how deeply penetrating or disruptive, have something to show you about your belief in the wisdom of your teachers, masters, and the angelic messengers who sweep through your daily lives. Change wakes you up to life as the spiritual process that it is. Change is different

from chance, because change is intended to bring you continually closer to God, while chance is purely the random movement of physical energy. Through change you, like an abundance of flowering blossoms, merge with the wisdom mind of God. You are continually offered the insight and ability to accept the angels drawn to you to heal the fear, pain, and anxiety that separate you from loving yourself as a divine aspect of the God-force.

Change is upsetting because the unknown has no discernible texture, no familiar faces, no assurances of success. When you are unable to ascertain what is coming into your life through the mist of change, it is easy and natural to be afraid. This fear, however, can create an impenetrable barrier to the divine love surging toward convergence into your life. APPLICATION

Make a list of these impending changes, and quietly, in each morning's meditation, place your hand over this list and imagine that a brilliant, divine light allows God's loving current to flow through you and out of your hand to bring positive and life-enhancing resolutions to these changes.

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
